POSTER PRESENTATION

Given the time constraints, poster presenters will be able to share their screen during a specific 15 min slot (see Schedule below), where they will answer questions and hold discussions. The last minutes of the session are allocated for free discussions with any of the poster presenters in the room (the moderator will give the word).

The moderator will also have the posters ready to share screen in case it is necessary.

As poster presenter, you can leave your BR to visit another one. The moderator will always be there to help you get back on track when you come back.
