Executive summary

I'm a scholar trained in history, history of ideas, gender studies, cultural analysis and sociology who has been employed at Science and Technology, History of Science as well as Human Geography divisions since 2003. As PI I've been responsible for nine research projects with a total budget of 52 million SEK. I'm part of two ongoing international research programs funded by EU Horizon and the Swedish Energy Agency. My international experience includes longer guest researchers stay, a number of conference keynotes, editor of special issues and anthologies as well as by invitation published in prestigious handbooks not least the *Elgar Encyclopedia of Environmental Sociology*. I've been main organiser of more than ten conferences and larger symposiums well as hosting a number of guest scholars at the *Centre for Studies of Climate Change Denial*.

The analyses that I've published range from large interdisciplinary collaborations to single authored historical of science accounts, printed in journals such as *Environmental Sociology*, *History and Technology*, *International Journal of Hydrogen Energy*, *Annual Review of Environment and Resources* and books in series such as *Palgrave History of Science* which have been cited 2535 times with an h-index of 23 and a i10-index 29 noted by google scholar. They include all from novel theoretical pieces, textbook in feminist STS & posthumanism (*Posthumanistiska nyckeltexter*) to popular reads, in six different languages. I also engage in general academic dialogues with reviews on important sociological work in the journals *Sociologisk forskning*, *Tidskriften för genusvetenskap* as well as on academic engagement in *Lychnos*. My teaching record include courses at all levels ranging from first year bachelor to PhD as well as giving talks all the way up to trial lectures for professorships; in total approximately 2600 hours. My supervision experience ranges from numerous bachelor and master thesis in different subjects over six PhD-students and four postdocs (of which four have succeeded and six are ongoing). Last, but not least, being a public intellectual I'm part of the societal dialogue regarding all my specialist areas.
