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
BACKGROUND

Gothenburg is growing, and with an increased population, the need for healthcare will grow aswell. According to forecasts, this means an increase of 100 000 specialist visits, compared to today's numbers. At the same time there is a desire to bring healthcare closer to the patient and bringing the functions of open specialist care and primary care closer together.

To meet the needs, two nearby hospitals are now being planned in Gothenburg. One is to be placed in Högsbo and the other in Frihamnen.

Frihamnen is an upcoming district located on Hisingen, just off the bridge Götaälvbron and very close to the city core. Today it serves as a harbour area, but by 2035 this will be the place for 20 000 inhabitants and around 20 000 workplaces. Harbour Health Nearby Hospital will be built in the first stage and the plan is to have it up and running by 2023.

THE HUMAN IN FOCUS

The hospital will be used by two main groups, with different needs and preconditions:



The users

The staff

Calmness and a feeling of safety is very important for the patients and visitors, but the hospital should at the same time serve as an efficient, well functional and pleasant work environment.

Three different factors have a particularly large impact on people's feelings, well being and experiences; the influence of nature, light and privacy.

NATURE



Pain

Nature is an effective positive distraction, which can reduce the perception of pain and the use of medication.

Length of stay

Nature views are healing and can affect the length of stay.

Stress

Exposing patients to nature lessens stress and anxiety.

Satisfaction

A view of nature increase staff and patient satisfaction.

DAYLIGHT/LIGHTING



Pain

Daylight reduces pain and the amount of pain medication.

Satisfaction

Good light conditions increase staff satisfaction.

Sleep

The natural and artificial lighting in patient rooms should follow the natural light during the day to provide good sleeping conditions.

Depression

Exposure to light is effective in reducing depression and improving mood.

PRIVACY

Integrity

An open waiting area may cause a feeling of exposure.

Satisfaction

Being able to stay for a longer time as a relative increases the satisfaction for both the patient and his/her relatives.

SITE ANALYSIS



The light conditions on the site are very good and there are several green areas in the neighbourhood.







Flows of pedstrians and bikes




Light study 17 april








SITE


The main entrance is situated in the northeastern corner. It is easy to spot from the big square where one arrives on public transport. A lot of space is also made in front of the entrance, both for seating and waiting for transportation services and taxis.

Connecting to the same area is also a restaurant/café open to the public. One can choose to sit on the streetside and watch the bustling life of the city, or to go into the building and enjoy the serene garden and airy spaces.

Entrance for staff and ambulance is located on the more quiet south side, so is the goods loading dock.

Where the streets are busier, shops are leasing the spaces. On the southwestern side you will find an expressgym for people on the go.








FORM CONCEPT




FOOTPRINT Starting with the footprint of the site.



U-SHAPED To create a calm courtyard the building takes the form of a u-shape.




TERRACED More private green areas is created for those departments where it is extra needed.

STRUCTURAL CONCEPT




STRUCTURE



COURTYARD & TERRACES



PSYCHIATRY TERRACE

On top of the building, with a fantastic view over Gothenburg's harbour, you find a calm garden for contemplation. Plants are carefully chosen to trig your senses and at the cultivating area for therapeutic activities the patients come close to the greenery. This terrace provides both quiet settings for reflection and embracing spaces for conversations in group.

PHYSIOTHERAPY TERRACE

This active terrace is designed to be used in the patient's treatment process. Variations in ground materials and levels challenge the patient's movement. There is also an outdoor gym that provides tools for workouts on your own, in groups or together with personnel.

STAFF TERRACE

On the 6th floor, where the administration department is located, the staff has easy access to their own terrace. You can go directly from the lunch room to enjoy your coffee and have a chat in the sun.


CHILDREN TERRACE


Children and families have the opportunity to wait outside in a green, playful and interactive environment. Here, on the sunny terrace, is space for eating, playing, climbing, running and exploring in green surroundings.

COMMON COURTYARD

The generous and sheltered courtyard is a peaceful garden, shared by patients, visitors, staff and restaurant guests. Surrounded by the hospital, the green area becomes a landmark for people using the building. The close connection to the restaurant and waiting areas invites you to enjoy a cup of coffee amongst the greenery or just to get some fresh air while you are waiting.


EXPANDABLE CONCEPT






The facade elements on a general wall.

To expand, the elements are removable within the ten metre grid.



A pre-fab module box is attached on the columns in the facade and reinforced in the slabs.




The buildings 10 x 10 m grid makes the rooms and corridors easy to keep general.

4-10 sqm 15 sqm 24 sqm 48 sqm 55/72 sqm

The grid allows changes to make rooms bigger and wider, in combination with the module box.





All boxes stick out 2,5 metres and can be installed where it is needed.




GROUND FLOOR

Most part of the ground floor is open to the public facing the streets. From the main entrance one is welcomed by the reception which will guide you further to the different departments of the hospital. All visitors are referred to use the lift or stairs adjacent to the reception.


The main hall offers a lounge with a big staircase which also serves as a seating area and can be used for lectures. On this floor, there is also a spiritual room for relaxing and contemplation.


When the hospital is closed, a folding wall divides the hall and the restaurant can be open at off hours.


When the goods arrive, it will be distributed to all other areas of the hospital through this floor. Therefore, this floor takes up the entire footprint of the site to enable easy logistics.








ENTRANCE HALL Ground floor


FLOOR 1

Both restaurant and main hall staircase leads to the courtyard greenery on floor 1. The courtyard serves as both an area for coffee and contemplation. All waiting areas and receptions are found outside the lifts. There are always big windows facing the garden from the waiting area on each floor.


Visitors who wants to check their health or leave samples, do so in the health room. Here are DIY check-in cubes, information and reading areas. The spacious room also allows exhibi-tions on health. Neighbouring departments are sampling and primary care.









HEALTH ROOM Floor 1

FLOOR 3


From the shared waiting area, with a smaller reception, the patient is guided to the department for pre and post operation. Further in, in the southern wing, the sterile zone is located. This is where the surgerys take place. After surgery the patient either recover back in the pre and post operation department, or is moved to a single bedroom at daycare. Since the operation theaters and the pre and post operation rooms require much space this floor is expanded on several places. These rooms have also been prioritised for good daylight conditions and a view for positive distraction and faster recovery.













FLOOR 5

At the pediatrics and youth department the main waiting area is twice as big as at the other departments. As on all floors an administration room with a reception is facing the waiting area. Cubes are placed over the floor and creates quiet, more private rooms or active spaces for play. Visitors can chose to visit the green terrace while they are waiting. Smaller lounge areas with daylight are provided for accompanying family members. To create lighter middle cores and airy corridors the rooms placed in the middle have gaps in between them and when possible glass walls.


